



## **SCHOOL OF CHOICE PROCESS** **2023/2024**

All elementary and rural elementary-secondary schools in the School District have a designated “catchment area.” If you wish your child to attend a school that is not their catchment school, a School of Choice application must be submitted.

- 1) Applicants must be registered at their respective catchment school **BEFORE** submitting a School of Choice application. A catchment area finder is available on the District website ([www.sd27.bc.ca](http://www.sd27.bc.ca))
- 2) Application forms may be obtained at all schools, the School District Office, or on the School District’s website ([www.sd27.bc.ca](http://www.sd27.bc.ca)).
- 3) Completed application forms are to be submitted to: [education@sd27.bc.ca](mailto:education@sd27.bc.ca) or Education Department: 350 Second Avenue Williams Lake, BC V2G 1Z9 between January 23, 2023 and March 8, 2023.
- 4) Parents will assume responsibility for travel and any additional costs incurred by a School of Choice approval.

### **French Immersion School – Nesika Elementary School & 100 Mile Elementary School**

New students wishing to register for French Immersion **must complete a School of Choice application IF it is not their regular catchment area school.**

School of Choice will be granted based on available room at the school and other relevant circumstances.

**Parents and schools will be notified in writing of the School of Choice decisions as soon as it is practicable.**

**If the application is denied, parents may request to be put on a waiting list to be considered by the second week of school in September.**
