



SCHOOL OF CHOICE PROCESS **2022/2023**

All elementary and rural elementary-secondary schools in the School District have a designated “catchment area.” If you wish your child to attend a school that is not their catchment school, a School of Choice application must be submitted.

- 1) Applicants must be registered at their respective catchment school **BEFORE** submitting a School of Choice application. A catchment area finder is available on the District website (www.sd27.bc.ca)
- 2) Application forms may be obtained at all schools, the School District Office, or on the School District’s website (www.sd27.bc.ca).
- 3) Completed application forms are to be submitted to: education@sd27.bc.ca or Education Department: 350 Second Avenue Williams Lake, BC V2G 1Z9 between January 17, 2022 and March 15, 2022.
- 4) Parents will assume responsibility for travel and any additional costs incurred by a School of Choice approval.

French Immersion School – Nesika Elementary School & 100 Mile Elementary School

New students wishing to register for French Immersion **must complete a School of Choice application IF it is not their regular catchment area school.**

School of Choice will be granted based on available room at the school and other relevant circumstances.

Parents and schools will be notified in writing of the School of Choice decisions as soon as it is practicable.

If the application is denied, parents may request to be put on a waiting list to be considered by the second week of school in September.
